My name is Scott Stewart and I have been teaching chess for 15 years. I am currently studying a bachelor's in mathematics and working for the chess tutoring company Chess Ideas where I coach juniors from Kinder to grade 6. I take groups of up to 26 students down to 1 on 1 sessions.

I teach chess all the chess basics and chess principles; how to play the opening stage of the game, how to approach and play the middle game and endgames, along with a myriad of other chess concepts. When I teach, I place a strong emphasis on chess practice. I run tournaments alongside all of my classes and encourage my students to play as often as possible. I stress learning tactics, mating patterns and I teach how to analyse a position, make decisions and how to make and execute a plan. These skills are relevant to all player' levels.

I have been an active tournament player for 30 years and have been teaching chess for 15 years. My highest ELO is a FIDE rating of 1928 and an ACF rating 1870. I am the current Ballarat Chess Club Champion, 2020, and I won back in 2007. Rates are negotiable; have a chat with me and we can work something out.
